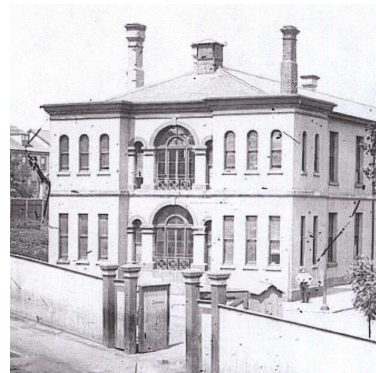


TRAIL-BLAZER IN MILITARY NURSING IN CANADA



Lieutenant Georgina Fane Pope

- born PEI, d/o Father of Confederation, William Henry Pope
- graduate Bellevue Hospital, NY
- 1899 served in the South African War, (Boer War) as Senior Nursing Sister
- in Charge Military Hospital at Kroonstadt
- 2nd tour of duty at Natal to 1902
- 1903 awarded Royal Red Cross for exceptional military nursing service
- worked at Garrison hospital, Halifax & became regular member - Canadian Army Med. Corps
- first Matron-in-Chief in 1908 of the Canadian Army Medical Corps
- **at 55 served in WW1 at Ypres “military band has power still to stir in me the longing to minister to the soldiers of the King.”**
